

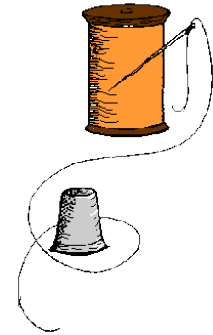
PRAYER QUILTS

Even if you don't know how to quilt, there are ways that you can help make a prayer quilt - and some of them don't even require sewing! You can either work at home or join us once a month at church to make prayer quilts.

Sign me up to:

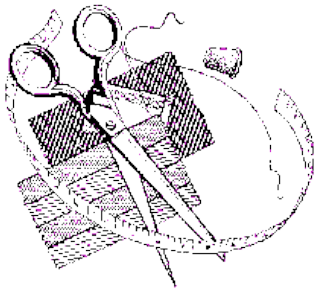
- Wash and iron fabric
- Cut fabric into squares or strips
- Piece quilt top (all quilt tops will be sewn by machine)
- Layer quilt (sandwich pieced top, batting and backing), secure with safety pins
- Sew binding on quilt (by machine)
- Turn binding and tack down (by hand or machine)
- Thread floss through quilt (the floss will be knotted during the prayer session)
- Oversee prayer/tying session
- Sew label on quilt
- ALL of the above
